

Gerald Kim, a senior at Fairfield Ludlowe High school in Fairfield, Connecticut, started to play the violin at age 7 and is currently studying under Wendy Sharp at the Yale School of Music. He has been a member of Greater Connecticut Youth Orchestra for 7 years and was assistant concertmaster in 2019-2020.

Gerald was the winner of the American Chamber Orchestra Concerto Competition in 2018 and Greater Connecticut Youth Orchestra Concerto Competition in 2019, and performed as soloist with both orchestras. He was a 2nd place winner of the Wallingford Symphony Concerto Competition in 2019. Gerald also was the winner of Musical Club of Hartford High School Music Competition, took 1st place of New York Artist International Competition, and placed 3rd in the International Grande Music Competition Chamber division. He also was a finalist in the Greater Bridgeport Symphony Orchestra Young Instrumentalist competition (final round canceled) in 2020. Most recently, he was the winner in Classical Music: Violin of the 2021 Young Arts National Competition.
