

**Joshua Hyuk Peiffer**, a senior at Fairfield College Preparatory School, Connecticut, has been studying flute for eight years and now is attending his second year at the Mannes School of Music Pre-College Program with Dr. Laura Gilbert as his flute teacher.

In summer 2019, he attended the Interlochen Center for the Arts Orchestral Program where he was a finalist in their Concerto Competition and chosen to perform in a Master Class with Amanda Blaikie, flutist in the Detroit Symphony Orchestra. In April 2019, Joshua was a member of the Greater Bridgeport Symphony "Side By Side" Mentoring Program which culminated in him performing with the orchestra in their spring concert. In summer 2018, he attended the Eastman School of Music Summer Classical Music Program. He placed third in the 2018 Marianne Liberatore Memorial Instrumental Competition, Southport, Connecticut, which awarded him a one-hour solo recital in September, 2019. During the 2018-2019 academic year, he was Principal Flute in both the Principal and Chamber Orchestras of the Greater Connecticut Youth Orchestras (GCTYO).

As a finalist in the GCTYO 2019 Concerto Competition, Joshua performed the first movement of Mozart's Concerto in G for Flute with their Chamber Orchestra. In February 2020, he was named a finalist in the Greater Bridgeport Symphony Young Instrumentalist Concerto Competition. He was accepted into Brevard Music Center and Boston University Tanglewood Institute for the summer of 2020 but these programs were cancelled.

After graduation from high school, Joshua plans to pursue a degree in classical flute performance. In addition, Joshua would like you to know that he enjoys drawing, singing, Latin and playing with the family beagle, Molly.
